

STORMY LAKE ASSOCIATION
MINUTES OF MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 3, 1978

The meeting of the Stormy Lake Association was called to order at 2PM at the Town Hall in Conover by the President, Richard Denis. Forty people attended. No minutes of the meeting of last year were available to be read. The treasurers report was given by the secretary in the absence of Margaret Habener, the treasurer.

The treasurers report was approved as read.

A letter was read relative to having a speaker from the Eagle River Hospital at a future meeting to inform the members of the various programs and facilities available. This will be considered by the board at a later date. Also discussed was the renewal of membership in the Wisconsin Federation of Lake Property Owners' Association. It was suggested by the board that no new membership be taken since there was little to be gained for our group other than a lobbying force, and since the dues were double from last year, it was decided that our Association refrain from joining.

Art Leu reported to the members on his correspondence with the D.N.R. relative to the quarterly sampling of Stormy Lake water. It has been scheduled for sometime after Labor Day. Art will report on their findings later. Also in regard to fish implantation Duane Williams volunteered to investigate future plans of the D.N.R. and report at the next meeting.

The subject of erecting name signs on our lake shore frontages was suggested by George Christl. He will report back to members about the size and cost of such a project.

Discussion of the Conover zoning regulations followed re: building. The ordinances are available from the secretary for anyone who is interested.

The subject of Ski-Scooters was brought up by Dorothy Walin who noted that excessive noise emitted from these new type water vehicles. A motion made by Art Leu and seconded by Muriel Leu that our Association go on record as agreeing to discourage the use of such vehicles due to the excessive noise factor was carried unanimously.

Also discussed was the practice of some individuals of using soap products in the lake for bathing shampooing hair, washing clothes, etc. A motion made by Dick Denis and seconded by Nonette Erdman was passed that a sign prohibiting such action be posted at the boat landing.

An announcement was made that there were extra copies of the Constitution available for new members of the Association.

The next order of business was the replacement of 2 members of the Nominating Committee. Doris Paulson and Dorothy Money have accepted these posts made vacant when Bernice Schaus and Dorothy Karstaedt moved.

The results of the survey for a social meeting were overwhelmingly favorable. Therefore a social gathering will be planned by the officers and Board for sometime during July, 1979.

Before adjournment each member introduced himself. A motion for adjournment was made by Paul Garside at 3:10 PM.
