ANNUAL MEETING - July 1, 1989, Town Hall, Conover

Officers & Directors Present: Dorothy Brust, Hugh Wurmle, Mariel Lou, Paul Garside, Bob Honey, Father Mithauf, Sandy Edwards, Dorothy Walin

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A. M. by President Dorothy Brust.

Members introduced themselves and indicated where they lived on beautiful Stormy Lake.

The minutes of the ANNUAL MEETING, 1988, read by Dorothy Brust, were approved and seconded by Mary M. Wurmle and Nancy Wurmle, respectively.

The treasurer's report was given by Mariel Lou, showing a beginning balance of \$612.84 in the General Checking Account and \$5.00 in the Fish Fund. A copy of the treasurer's report is attached. The account has been audited by Mary M. Wurmle and Nancy Wurmle and found to be correct. Dorothy Walin moved that the treasurer's report be accepted; Joan Cook seconded this motion.

Dorothy Brust read and explained the proposed budget for the coming year:

Tribute was paid to Paul Garside and Les Hedstrom for saving the lives of several people on Stormy Lake. We are fortunate to have such wonderful, alert, caring people on our lake.

Bob Honey reported that the Conover 'backlot' ordinance was defeated. The Vilas County 'backlot', lake access ordinance is in effect. Check with Joan Hanson in Conover or John Anderson at the court house if you have questions concerning this issue.

Fish Report Paul Garside reported that 12,000 Brook Trout and 20,000 Brown Trout were planted this past year in Stormy Lake. He reported that the MNR did a check on PCB and mercury levels in our lake; we are OK. North Twin has mercury.

Fish Contest Paul Garside reports that the fishing contest begins opening day and runs to the first week before the Colorama Dinner. There are four categories: L. Mouth Bass, Brown Trout, Rainbow Trout, others. Paul Garside will weigh your fish; if he is unavailable, Bob Honey will serve as his 'back-up'.

New Business Nancy Wurde wanted to know how we could get an update on names of new people on the lake. Dorothy Walin stated that an update of new names is sent out with the newsletter. Colorama Dinner invitations are sent to members only.

Mary Wurde informed us that the vice-president's name should have been on the ballot when he/she is running for president. We will remember this for future elections.

Dorothy Brust stated that there have been questions concerning Jet-Skis. Jet-Ski rules are the same as State Boat Regulations. (Regulations are printed on page 2 of the directory.) Basically, they may ski from sun-up to sunset - stay 100 feet away from piers - and be considerate!

Volunteers were asked to be boat judges for the Boat Parade. Dorothy Walin and Gloria Bianchini volunteered.

Mary C. Wurde mentioned that \$25.00 was donated to the Cranberry Fitness Walk last year by our association. A brown bag was circulated this year for donations. The walk takes place the first Saturday in October.

Ed Brust encouraged everyone to write a note of thanks to Don Segler for road clearing and sign repair. D. Brust said that the new chairman of the Conover Town Council is Shirley Henriks.

Warren Anderson asked if we could send a letter to the DNR about making improvements on our precarious boat landing. Ed Brust informed us that the forestry department is responsible for boat landings. Tom Fegers is the one to call. He told Ed that \$10,000 has been allocated in Vilas County for boat landing improvements; we are on the list.

Bob Williams announced the election report. Fifty-four votes were tallied.
