

Stormy Lake Association Annual Meeting

July 2, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am. by Debbie Benson at the Conover Center. 66 people were in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. A moment of silence was held for the following residents who have died in the past year: Gordon Miller, Roland Toefert, #####

Secretary's minutes had been sent out for the 2022 Annual Meeting. A correction to replace "appointed" with "election" was made for the election of Board of Directors.

Vice Presidents' report was given by Sandy Sieber. Social events from the past year were held including monthly dinners, and an ice cream social.
