

STORMY LAKE ASSOCIATION

MINUTES OF MEETING OF JULY 8, 1979

After a pleasant coffee hour about sixty-five (65) members of the Stormy Lake Association began their membership meeting at 2:05 pm in the Conover Town Hall. The minutes of the September 3, 1978 meeting and the treasurer's report were read and approved. The current balance in the treasury is \$394.86.

In the absence of the president, Dick Denis, Board Member Art Leu conducted the meeting. He began by having each member introduce himself. Following this, Art reported that the D.N.R. had tested the quality of the water in Stormy Lake on Aug. 28, 1978, February 2, 1979 and May 5, 1979 and rated the quality excellent. Since Duane Williams (Board Member) was absent George Christl read a report sent by Duane about fish implantation. Regarding replacement of fish shelters which are deteriorating, it is possible that in the 1979-80 year work on this could be done providing Federal funding and manpower are available. George also reported on lakeside routed name signs and said if anyone wished to order one they could sign up after the meeting; the cost is \$15.50 plus tax for a 28" X 8" sign. Another report was given by George on the passing of County Resolution #79-41 giving the F.A.A. permission to build an air navigation tower on Stormy Hill across the road from Four Seasons resort.

At this time Margaret Habener presented the nominees for the vacant offices and the ballots were collected and counted. The candidates recommended by the nominating committee were elected. They are: GEORGE CHRISTL - PRESIDENT; DAVE MILLER - VICE PRESIDENT; NILS OLSON - BOARD MEMBER (replacing Cliff Anderson); DORIS PAULSON - BOARD MEMBER (replacing Dave Miller).

Then followed an open discussion....It was suggested by Don Olson that a list of regulations re: water skiing, boating etiquette and do's and don'ts to prevent water pollution be compiled and distributed to each home. A motion was made by Vernoy Johnson and seconded by Ed Van Steenberg to publish such a list. The motion carried. It was also suggested that a letter be sent to the owners of property on Pearl Lake reminding them of the no trespassing signs leading into Stormy Lake. Vernoy Johnson will supply names and addresses to the Secretary.

At its' last meeting the board discussed the possibility of an Association Dinner to be held for the membership sometime around Colorama time. A motion was made by Ed Hamming and seconded by Arnie Carlson that the social function be held. Members voted in favor of this event and a committee comprised of Maggie Oschmann, Donna Wesling and Martha Vinecore volunteered to work out the details.

The meeting adjourned at 3:20 pm.
